Launch of the UI GreenMetric 2025 Questionnaire

Depok, June 18, 2025 — Universitas Indonesia, through its global initiative UI GreenMetric World University Rankings, is pleased to announce that the UI GreenMetric 2025 questionnaire is now officially open, from June 18 to October 31, 2025. All higher education institutions worldwide are invited to participate in this annual effort to promote environmental sustainability in the academic sector.

In 2024, UI GreenMetric achieved a record-breaking milestone with 1,477 universities from 95 countries participating—reflecting its continued growth as the largest sustainability ranking for universities in the world. Since its establishment in 2010, UI GreenMetric has evolved beyond a ranking system into a global movement, encouraging systemic transformation in higher education institutions and positioning them as key agents of change toward a more sustainable future.

Strengthening Indicators for 2025

The 2025 questionnaire continues to use six main criteria: (1) Setting and Infrastructure; (2) Energy and Climate Change; (3) Waste Management; (4) Water Management; (5) Transportation; and (6) Education and Research. Several important updates have been introduced to this year's questionnaire, including:

New Impact-Based Questions

Each criterion now includes additional questions focusing on the measurable impact of programs implemented by universities, aiming to capture not only the existence of initiatives but also their real-world effectiveness.

Enhancements to the Waste Management Criterion:

- Total volume of paper and plastic generated in the current year
- Total volume of organic and inorganic waste generated and treated
- Total volume of hazardous (toxic) waste generated and treated

Enhancements to the Education and Research Criterion:

- Number of academic programs related to sustainability
- Number of scholarly publications on sustainability within the past year
- Number of active lecturers and researchers on campus
- Ratio of sustainability publications to academic staff, providing a fairer comparison across institutions of varying sizes
- Number of graduates over the past three years

- Percentage of graduates employed in green jobs over the past three years (weighted at 50 points)
- Impact of education and research programs in supporting the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)

In response to the increasing quality and depth of institutional data, several question weightings have also been revised to ensure greater accuracy and fairness in the ranking methodology.

UI GreenMetric is committed to inclusivity and equal opportunity. Participation in the ranking is completely free of charge, ensuring that all institutions—regardless of size, status, or location—can contribute to and benefit from this global benchmarking initiative.
